Born September 11, 1940 in Livingston, NY, he was the son of the late Edison and Gertrude Pierce Chichester. Mr. Chichester was currently a member of Thee Baptist Worship Center and Kairos Prison Ministry for 20 years and a former member of Mercy Baptist Church. He was a retired Chief Inspector of roadways, tunnels and bridges after 28 years of service.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughters, Denise Marie Guiradano, Dierdre Fitzgerald and a son, Michael Carrington brother, James Chichester and a sister Mary Esposito.
