Conway...Jackson Lee Hardee, age 24, passed away Saturday, October 5, 2019 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

Jackson was born May 23, 1995 in Loris, a son of Joseph Michael Hardee and Donna Marie Buckley Hardee. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and loved telling stories. Jackson enjoyed helping others and his final act of giving was as an organ donor. He was predeceased by his paternal and maternal grandparents.

Surviving in addition to his parents are a brother, Preston Hardee (Courtney); his special cousins, Dallas Jones and Matthew Hardee; many aunts, uncles, cousins, and other extended family; and his 4 legged buddy "Doc".

Funeral services will be held at 3:00 PM Thursday, October 10, 2019 at Langston Baptist Church with Rev. John Holmes officiating. Entombment will follow in Hillcrest Mausoleum. The family will receive friends from 4:00 PM until 7:00 PM Wednesday at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel.
