Timothy Carrol ``T.C.' Cox, 19, of Murrells Inlet died Saturday, June 7 as the result of an automobile accident. Born Jan. 19, 1989, he was the son of Bryan and Sarah Marie ``Sam' Cox of Murrells Inlet. T.C. was a 2007 graduate of Waccamaw High School and was attending the University of South Carolina in Columbia, where he was a member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity. He was employed at Drunken Jacks Restaurant in Murrells Inlet during breaks from school. T.C. was a fun-loving, easy-going young man who always had a smile on his face and offered a hug or a pat on the back. He loved boating, fishing and supporting his Gamecocks athletic teams. He will be sorely missed by his family and many friends.
