Mr. A. Jay Lowe Jr., husband of Fray Lowe, passed away unexpectedly the morning of Tuesday, October 3, 2023 at Georgetown Memorial Hospital.

A. Jay was born on October 23rd, 1951 in Giles County, VA, the youngest son of A. Jay Lowe Sr. and Loma Dell Sweeney Lowe. Now retired and an avid outdoorsman, he could always be found riding his Harley, fishing, boating, watching baseball or working on projects in his workshop at home for his family. 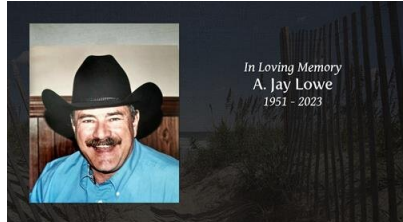

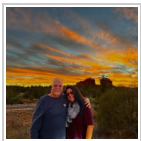
