Adelle Booth Hucks Johnson, 78, left us on October 23, 2017, at her home in Aynor, South Carolina with her family by her side. She was the wife of John "JD" Johnson.

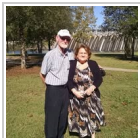

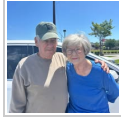
