Conway...Albert James Kappes, Jr., age 90, passed away Wednesday, August 26 at Conway Medical Center.

Jim was born on October 24, 1924 in Waynesburg, PA, a son of the late Albert and Roxanne Kappes. He joined the US Navy shortly after Pearl Harbor and attacked and served his country during World War II seeing action aboard the USS Sigsby in the Pacific Theater. Following the war, he worked as an electrician at TRANSCO for many years and later as a building superintendant on construction sites. After retiring in 1981, Jim and his wife, Ann, moved from Maryland to Delaware to enjoy living closer to the water. They also lived along the Gulf Coast in Florida for many years before moving to the Myrtle Beach area in 2008 to be closer to their daughter. He was predeceased by his wife, Anna M. Kappes.

Jim loved to fish, both in Delaware and Florida, and made many friends along the way. He enjoyed reading western novels and watching old westerns on television. He took great pleasure in going out for breakfast several days a week at a local favorite restaurant.

Surviving are his son, James Kappes, III and his wife, Gail; daughter, Bonita A. Pruiem and her husband, Robert, as well as six grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren.
