February 18, 1921 - January 18, 2014

Alene Doyle Huggins, 92, of Loganville, GA, originally of Aynor, died Saturday, January 18 after a long illness.

She was born February 18, 1921 in Cool Springs to the late Henry and Bessie Rabon Doyle, the fifth of six children. Mrs. Huggins lived most of her adult life in Aynor and worked 29 years at the Aynor Post Office and as a rural mail carrier from the 1940s to the 1970s. She loved reading, spending time with family and friends, cooking, gardening, and being active in her church. Mrs. Huggins was preceded in death by her husband, Milton Huggins and her daughter, Linda Huggins Rogers.

Survivors include a grandson, Jeff and his wife Penny Rogers and their children Janie and Lawson Rogers of Tucker, GA, grandson Doyle Rogers of Jefferson, GA, sister Genny Bestermann of Myrtle Beach as well as many nieces, nephews and cousins. In her final years she was cared for by a faithful sitter and close friend, Joanne Johnson.
