Pawleys Island Alexander Banfield Chisholm, age 90 of Sweetgum Drive died Wednesday, October 25, 2006 at his home. Born May 28, 1916 in Oakville, Ontario, Canada, he was the son of the late W.A. and Charlotte Taylor Chisholm.
