



Alfred Olivetti

February 21, 1935 - December 24, 2012

Alfred M. Olivetti passed away Monday, December 24, 2012 following a battle with lung cancer. He was 77 years old.

Alfred was born in Kankakee, Illinois one of three children by George and Mary Olivetti. He graduated from St. Patrick's High School and a member of St. Rose Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee before enlisting in the US Army. He left military service as a veteran of the Korean War and then enrolled at Northern Illinois University, before returning to his home to marry his beloved wife, Jacqueline Bulliner Olivetti. He worked in corporate sales and relocated throughout the eastern United States before settling in Myrtle Beach in 1972. In Myrtle Beach, he started in real estate sales and grew into real estate development over the past 40 years. Al was very active in his church and the community. He was among those who helped establish St. Michael's Catholic Church in Garden City and was a long time member of the Knights of Columbus and other civic organizations. He was active in local and state politics and an avid golfer.

Al is survived by his two sisters, Teresa Eppel of Chicago Heights, Illinois and Diane Anderson of Denver, Colorado, as well as his sister-in-law Mary Bulliner of Kankakee, Illinois. He is also survived by his five children, Michael Olivetti of Hilton Head, Lisa Olivetti McGahan of Atlanta, Vincent Olivetti of Surfside Beach, Stasia Olivetti Bryant of Columbia, and Alfred Olivetti Jr. of Hilton

Head, and fifteen grandchildren.

A Funeral Mass will be held 9:30 a.m. Friday, December 28, 2012 at St. Michael's Catholic Church and burial will follow in Hillcrest Cemetery.
