Mrs. Aliecia June "Lee" Philbin, 83, widow of the late William Thomas "Bill" Philbin, passed away Monday, November 6, 2023 at Conway Medical Center following a brief onset illness.

Born June 5, 1940 in Syracuse, NY, Mrs. Philbin was the daughter of the late Francis Donald Shank and the late Aliecia Anderson Shank. Lee retired from the United States Forestry Service following 21 years as an administrative officer. She was of the Catholic faith and previously attended St. Paul Episcopal Church in Conway. Lee and Bill were members of Lakeshore Yacht and Country Club in Cicero, NY and at Myrtle Beach National when they retired to South Carolina. They enjoyed golfing together and participating in ballroom dancing. Mrs. Philbin was a former president of the Women's Golf Association at Lakeshore and a member of the Southcreek Ladies' Bridge Club in Myrtle Beach. She was an incredibly skilled cook but was even more famously known for her baking. Lee was an avid supporter of Syracuse University and a fan of the men's basketball and football programs.

Mrs. Philbin was predeceased by her devoted husband of 67 years, Bill Philbin, who passed away Tuesday, October 31, 2023 and her son, Jerald Donald Philbin.
