Mr. Allen L. Ray, age 85, well-respected attorney and Southern Gentleman of Conway, after a long illness at home, went to be with God on Friday, April 17, 2015.

Mr. Ray was born in Georgetown, SC on September 22, 1929, the son of O. B. and Ella Goude Ray. He is survived by his wife and partner of 65 years, Jo Ann C. Ray, of Conway; a son and daughter-in-law, Gregory A. Ray and Ingrid S. Ray, of Mt. Pleasant, S.C.; and three grandchildren, Jackson, Harrison, and Grace, all of Mt. Pleasant, S.C. Also surviving are a godson and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Harish Mamtani, of Atlanta, Ga. He will be buried at Hillcrest Cemetery in Conway beside his daughter, Martha Ann Ray.

In addition to serving on many and various civic committees and organizations Mr. Ray was a United States Navy Korean War Veteran. He served for many years as City of Conway Judge and he practiced law in the various area courts and in the South Carolina and Federal Supreme Courts. Mr. Ray was awarded the South Carolina Order of the Palmetto. He served on and chaired the South Carolina Ethics Commission; and he was twice given the Boss of the Year award of the Horry County Legal Secretaries Association. Mr. Ray was a member of First United Methodist Church of Conway where he served as chairman of the Pastor Parish Committee, chairman of the Trustees, and had taught the college age Sunday School class for many years.

Funeral services will be held at 3:00PM Monday, April 20, 2015 at First United Methodist Church of Conway. Burial will follow in Hillcrest Cemetery. The family will receive friends in the Church Commons from 2:00PM until 3:00PM Monday.
