



Amanda Criswell

March 18, 1981 - January 21, 2015

Amanda Criswell died peacefully in her sleep at her home in Carolina Forest, S.C., on Wednesday morning. She was 33 years old.

Amanda was a 1999 graduate of Apollo Ridge High School in Spring Church, Penn., and a 2003 graduate of The Pennsylvania State University with a B.A. in Journalism. While at Penn State, Amanda was a staff member of the Daily Collegian, the Penn State student-run newspaper. She also completed internships with the Pennsylvania Center for the Book, the Centre Daily Times, and the Valley News Dispatch.

After the completion of her degree, Amanda began her career at the Index-Journal in Greenwood, S.C., as a Copy Desk Editor. In 2006, Amanda moved to Myrtle Beach, S.C., after accepting a job at The Sun News as a Page Designer. During her time at The Sun News, Mandy won several S.C. Press Awards for her design talents and designed hundreds of pages read by many throughout the Grand Strand. Joining The Sun News made her happy to be able to live so close to her family at the beach.

Throughout her life, Mandy, as she was known to her friends and family, always easily made friends and was well-respected by her colleagues for her strong work ability and immense talent. She enjoyed traveling and had the opportunity to visit Ireland this past summer with one of her best friends. She also enjoyed baking cupcakes for co-workers, friends and family, and organizing parties and events. Amanda loved shopping and finding a good

bargain and spending time at the beach, recently remarking to friends that "nothing beats falling asleep to the sound of waves crashing along the shore."

Amanda is survived by her parents, Judy and Paul Criswell of Surfside; her brother, Matt Criswell and sister-in-law Missy Criswell of Lyman; and several aunts, uncles, cousins and friends scattered across the country.

Two visitations will be held Saturday - from 2-4 p.m. and from 6-8 p.m. - at Goldfinch Funeral Home Beach Chapel, 11528 Highway 17 Bypass, Murrells Inlet, S.C. A memorial service will be held 2 p.m. Sunday, also at Goldfinch Beach Chapel.

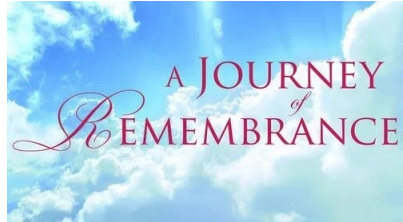
