Amber Leigh Ogle Dunn passed away on June 16, 2013. Amber was born on August 7, 1970 in the Naval Hospital at Great Lakes, Illinois. She was the first child of Gwen and Ray Ogle. Amber attended elementary school in Sherman, Texas, and then graduated from Gaither High School in Tampa, Florida. Amber then attended Syracuse University in New York State, and graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Marketing. She began her professional career as a pharmaceutical sales representative in Buffalo, New York. An ever-increasing interest in computers, information technology and graphic art encouraged Amber to move to Los Angeles, California where she lived for ten years and worked in the web-based advertising industry. An opportunity with Classmates.com brought her and her new family to the Seattle area in 2004 where she continued her advertising career.
