Mrs. Anna Genevieve Todisco, 93, widow of the late Arthur Todisco, passed away Wednesday, October 15, 2025.

Born November 3, 1931 in Boston, MA, she was the daughter of the late John Rogers and the late Catherine O'Toole Rogers. Mrs. Todisco raised her four children in Totowa, NJ and cherished her time as a stay-at-home mom.
