Armatha Hemingway, age 91, passed away Sunday, August 10, 2025.

she would think about God's goodness and all that He had done for her! Then, she would break out in a loud out of tune song, a prayer, or just praise and worship of the Lord. Armatha didn't mind giving God the praise that He deserved no matter where she was, what was going on at the time, or who was around. She Loved God Out Loud and didn't care who knew it. Armatha had an out spoken personality and will be greatly missed.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her daughter, Alice Hemingway; four brothers, Elbert Hemingway, Joe David Hemingway, Ander Hemingway, and Lee Davis Hemingway; and two sisters, Angeline Hemingway and Carrie Lee Hemingway.
