



## Arnold Johanson

January 29, 1929 - April 18, 2012

Arnold "Arnie" Johanson, age 83 died April 18, 2012 following an illness. Mr. Johanson was born in East Boston, MA, a son of the late Hilmer and Aagot A. Aanensen Johanson.
