Arthur Todisco, age 95, passed away Saturday, December 26, 2020.

Born November 17, 1925 in East Boston, Massachusetts, he was the son of the late Anthony and Catherine Todisco. Mr. Todisco and his wife, who were married for 69 years, were devout Catholics. Mr. Todisco played softball and was an avid fan of all Boston sports teams.

He was a veteran of the United States Army, serving his country during World War II.

Mr. Todisco raised his family in Totowa, NJ. He retired to Florida with his wife for the next 24 years, where they enjoyed playing golf. He then spent the next 10 years in Myrtle Beach.
