Aubrey Hardwick, age 87, of Juniper Bay Road, passed away Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Mr. Hardwick was born August 28, 1932 in Aynor, a son of the late Jeremiah Evander and Leona Phipps Hardwick. He was a member of Cool Springs Southern Methodist Church where he served on the Board of Stewards. Mr. Hardwick was the owner and operator of Olympia Skate Arena "Hardwicks" for 41 years and Unique Glass Company for 68 years.
