Aurellia C. Simon, age 84, died Saturday, November 2, 2013 at her home in Myrtle Beach surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Orange NJ on July 3, 1929, Mrs. Simon was the daughter of the late Elkanah and Iris Campbell. She is predeceased by her brother, John Cyrus Campbell.

A 1947 graduate of East Orange High School, Mrs. Simon graduated in 1953 with her RN degree from Harlem Hospital School of Nursing and from the New York University 1957 with her BS degree. She taught nursing at the Long Island College Hospital and the Pediatric Institute in Brooklyn, NY. Mrs. Simon also served as a Pediatric Instructor at Clara Maas in Bellville, NJ. Her career path allowed her to work in many fields of nursing as well as in several hospitals and homes before her retirement in 1999.

After moving to Myrtle Beach from East Orange, NJ in 1995, Mrs. Simon joined the Episcopal Church of the Resurrection where she was an active member involved in the choir, Episcopal Church Women and served as a lay reader. She also enjoyed volunteering with Mobile Meals and as a mentor at St. James Grade School.
