Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel, is serving the family.

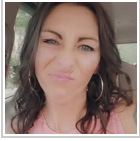

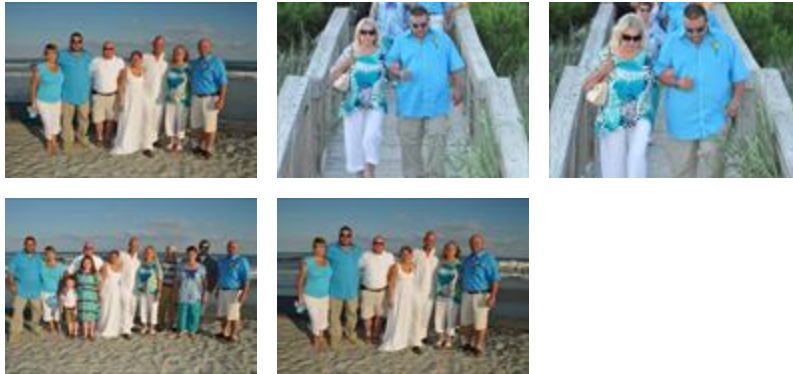
# Tribute Wall
