Barbara Lynne Lloyd, 74 of Myrtle Beach died Wednesday, January 15, 2014 at her home surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Lima, Ohio, she was the daughter of the late James and Rebekah Baxter. Mrs. Lloyd owned Barbara Lynne's School of Dance in Elida, Ohio for 36 years and was a dance instructor at Marla's School of Dance in Surfside Beach for 12 years. Having a generous and loving spirit, Mrs. Lloyd donated the proceeds from her dance recitals to the St. Jude Children's Hospital.
