Mrs. Barbara R. Thompson, 82, widow of John C. Thompson, passed away Thursday, September 29, 2016 at Conway Medical Center following a brief illness.

Born October 16, 1933 in Bennettsville, SC she was the only daughter of the late Clarence H. and Clarice Richardson. After graduating as salutatorian from Bennettsville High School in 1951, she attended the University of South Carolina where she was a member of Chi Omega Sorority. She held various offices in her sorority and at the University during her four years. In 1955 she graduated Cum Laude from the University with a Bachelor of Arts degree. From 1955 to 1957 she taught business courses at Eau Claire High School in Columbia. Barbara married John Coleman Thompson in 1957 and moved to Conway where she taught English and history for five years. She was a member of Thomas Memorial Baptist Church in Bennettsville and later was a charter member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Conway.

Mrs. Thompson is survived by her sister, Frankie Warden Hughes and husband Jay; her special nephew Phil Thompson and wife Pat; and many other nephews and extended family.
