Benjamin Julian Creel, age 51, of Conway died November 8, 2016 at Grand Strand Hospital, surrounded by family and friends.

Benjamin was born in Conway, SC, a son of the late Paul Creel and the late Dolores Creel. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Russell. He is survived by his sisters, Paula Floyd of Aynor, Meredith Neal and Michelle Richardson of Conway, 12 nieces and nephews: Elliot Smith (Deidre), Daniel Smith (Erin), Reuben Smith, A.J. He was an attorney and past owner and CEO of Creel Oil & Gas and the North American Institute of Aviation. Benjamin was an active member of the Conway Chamber of Commerce where he served as President in 1996-1997 and was named Man of the Year in 1998. He was also active in the Conway Rotary Club, the Horry Citadel Club, and the Conway Medical Center Foundation.

Benjamin enjoyed hunting, camping, cooking, Nascar, golf, and entertaining friends and family at his home, Tar Kiln Branch. He particularly enjoyed his annual "Burning of the Greens" which he hosted for many years on the first Saturday in January.

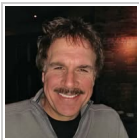

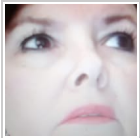
