Surfside Beach Bernard "Bud" Charles Tracey, age 84, of Oceanside Village, died Saturday, August 26, 2006 at his residence. Born April 11, 1922 in Schenectady, NY, he was the son of the late Bernard and Natalie Sparks Tracey. Mr. Tracey was a graduate of Christian Brothers Academy in Albany, NY. He was a retired firefighter in Schenectady, NY, and a lifelong volunteer firefighter. Mr. Tracey was a US Army WWII veteran of the 3rd infantry division landing at Anzio Beach.
