Conway, SC...Berniece DuBose Chestnut, age 99, wife of the late Webster Robert Chestnut, died March 19, 2014.

Mrs. Chestnut was born in Socastee, SC, the daughter of the late William Albert DuBose and Belle Smith DuBose. She worked for The American Red Cross during WWII, was a member of First Baptist Church, Conway and retired from Conway High School as secretary to the principal. Mrs. Chestnut was predeceased by a brother, Malchus Dubose; three sisters: Alsadie Risher, Rena Belle Elkes and Lila Royals.
