



## Betty D. Fleming

Betty D. Fleming, age 90, passed away Saturday, November 9, 2024.

Mrs. Fleming was born in Claxton, GA a daughter of the late Jebez Wade Damon and the late Fannie Eakin Damon. She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Conway since her marriage in 1955 where she served as the WMU Director for 25 years. Mrs. Fleming also served as the WMU Area Director for Waccamaw Baptist Association for 20 years. She was a member of the Sunshine Sunday School Class and was Treasurer for the Women on Missions Bible Study Group. Mrs. Fleming served on several mission trips, traveling to Louisiana after Hurricane Katrina as well as Greenwich, CT and the Bronx, NY.

Mrs. Fleming helped operate concession stands for the Booster Club when her sons played Dixie Youth baseball and was the bookkeeper for her husband's business, Fleming Brothers Photo Service. She was also the owner and bookkeeper for Fleming Fire Extinguisher Service for 59 years.

Mrs. Fleming was a great influence as a christian, wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, and great-great grandmother, church member, and friend. She always had faith, hope, and love because she knew God as her Father,

Jesus Christ as His Son, and the Holy Spirit that led her everyday.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Fleming was predeceased by her husband, Lonnie W. Fleming, Sr.; one son, Michael W. Fleming; and one brother, Gary Damon.

Survivors include two sons, Lonnie W. Fleming, Jr. (Mary Cumbie) of Conway and Kenneth L. Fleming (Cindy) of Columbia, SC; three grandchildren, Lonnie W. Fleming, III (Kayla) of Conway, Jessica Fleming of Socastee, and Keri Fleming Worthington of Washington, DC; two great grandchildren; and three great-great grandchildren.
