Dateline... Socastee Betty Richardson Henson-Bini, age 43, beloved wife of Dillio Bini III, of Shem Creek Circle in Socastee, died Saturday, October 28, 2006 at her residence. Mrs. Henson-Bini was born in Myrtle Beach, SC, a daughter of the late William Dock and Evelyn Holden Richardson. She was predeceased by a sister, Christine Richardson Lown and a brother, Jerry C. Richardson. She worshipped at River of Life Church of God in Conway. Mrs. Henson-Bini attended Horry County Public Schools and graduated from Myrtle Beach High School in 1981, attended Baptist College of Charleston and the University of South Carolina, graduating with a BA in Education in 1991. She worked with Anderson Family Resorts from 1985-1992 and then at North Conway Baptist Church until 1997. Mrs. Henson-Bini will best be remembered for her devotion to her children, her compassion for others, and her inspiring determination to live life fully despite the complications of her illness. She had been treated for invasive breast cancer beginning in 2000 but suffered from terminal brain metastasis in 2002. During the course of her illness, Mrs. Henson-Bini attended Webster University and graduated with Honors with a Master's Degree in Counseling. She was employed as a clinical counselor in the addictions treatment program at Georgetown County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission. She had also served as a Crisis Line volunteer for the Grand Strand Community Against Rape and was an intern and volunteer for Citizens Against Spouse Abuse. Surviving in addition to her loving husband and caregiver are: a son, Timothy Patrick Henson II; a daughter, Patricia

Scarlett Henson; and her former husband and friend, Timothy Patrick Henson all of Myrtle Beach; three sisters, Bobbi Lane and her husband Dickie of North Carolina, Pauline Richardson Hamilton, and Lois Richardson Weatherford both of Myrtle Beach; two brothers, James Richardson and his wife June of Myrtle Beach, Buddy Richardson of Socastee; an uncle, Rev. Winford Richardson and his wife Nina of Florida; an aunt, Esther Holden Hair of Louisiana; several nieces and nephews; great nieces and nephews; and several cousins. A memorial service will be held at 4:00 P.M. Wednesday from Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel with Rev. Sherrod Barfield officiating.
