Beulah E. Watson, age 97 of Hagley Drive died Tuesday, February 24, 2004 at home. Born November 23, 1906 in Omaha, Texas, she was one of eight children of the late Joseph Daniel and Mila Belle Ried Taylor. Mrs. Watson was a member of the Missionary Baptist Church in Texas and Washington, DC where she was a Sunday School teacher. She was an elementary school teacher in Texas. Mrs. Watson was a graduate of George Washington University and worked for the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture. She was an Accountant and Budget Analyst for the Dept of Agriculture and would testify before Congress. After retiring in 1969, she moved to California to care for her mother, then to Texas in 1981 to care for her sister and to the area in 1991 to be near her family. Mrs. Watson was preceded in death by her husband Grover who died in 1936 at the age of 44. Surviving are her daughter Elizabeth Hileman and husband Mel; granddaughter, Victoria Hileman; grandson, Scott Hileman; beloved sister, Oralee Burrer and husband Elgin of Texas; many nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews, great grandnieces and nephews in Texas and California.
