Bobby Jerry "B.J." Sellers, age 69 of Conway, died Wednesday November 30, 2005 at his residence. Born September 26, 1936 in Chesterfield, SC he was a son of the late Luther M. and Clara Moore Sellers. Mr. Sellers was a member of the First Baptist Church of Conway, a member of the Angler B. Sunday School Class, a former Deacon of North Conway Baptist Church, and was a member of the American Legion Conway Post #111. He began his career as a State Patrolman in 1958, during that time he also issued driver's licenses for about 16 years, retiring from the State Highway Patrol in 1980. He then began full time with the SC National Guard and later retired in 1996. He was a loving and devoted husband, father, and grandfather. Surviving is his wife of 47 years Miriam T.
