



Boyd David DuMont

January 4, 1958 - November 10, 2023

Boyd David DuMont, cofounder of DuMont Brother's Construction Company in Pawleys Island,

South Carolina, passed away November 11, 2023, surrounded by his loving family. He was 65.

He was born in Malone, New York, the second oldest of six children of David and K. Clare

DuMont. He grew up in Potsdam, New York and began working at a young age in his father's

construction company. He learned very early in life the importance of hard work and the value

of a large, loving family.

Following graduating from Potsdam High School in 1976, Boyd attended Canton Agricultural

and Technical College where he took courses related to the building industry.

He soon started

working full time in his fathers' business and there learned the skills of all the different jobs

needed to build and remodel homes.

Boyd married Suzanne Griffin in 1980. They moved to South Carolina in 1982 to begin building

a future for their soon to be very large family. Boyd cofounded the successful construction

company, DuMont Brother's Builders, with his father and brother, and worked tirelessly to ensure its success. The company's success and the outstanding reputation it has in the area, is one of his greatest accomplishments.

Boyd was most proud of his other major accomplishment, creating with his wife a loving and supportive family, all of whom are equally hard workers and family focused. He is survived by

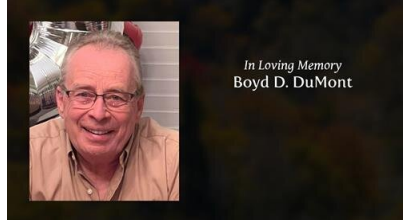
