



## Brian Edward Mack

Mr. Brian Edward Mack, born August 17, 1960, age 61, passed away in Pawleys Island, SC on Sunday, October 3rd, 2021, shortly after relocating to the area with his wife, Teresa, to live out their retirement dreams.

Brian was a jack of all trades, a “Mr. Fix It”, and a small engine wiz. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed golfing with his dad, son Andy and many friends.
