Buddy Williams, age 69, died Tuesday, January 18, 2022 at his residence. Born in Bennettsville, SC, David J. Williams, Jr. was a son of the late Mary T. and David J. Williams Sr. Buddy was a graduate of Myrtle Beach High School and attended Coastal Carolina University. He was a member of the Tabernacle of Meetings Church in Surfside Beach where he was involved in the Food Bank Ministry.

Buddy was also an avid golfer. In previous years, he was involved in the “Wednesday Group” at the Dunes Club. He used his love of golf to help those in need by facilitating golf tournaments for charity.

In addition, Buddy helped further the ministry of Street Reach Mission which housed and fed the homeless of Myrtle Beach. He was also active in the Sertoma Club and Ducks Unlimited. In recent years, he helped organize a monthly Pastors Prayer Luncheon for pastors in the Sumter area.
