



Burns Robertson

November 8, 1925 - January 23, 2016

Burns H. Robertson, age 90, died on January 23, 2016 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Born in Quebec, Canada, Mr. Robertson was a son of the late George W. and Edna H. Robertson. He moved to Middleburg, VA at the age of 5. He was a small business owner, and operated the BP service station in Middleburg, for 40 years. He also operated the Exxon service station in Upperville for 15 years. He was a WWII veteran in two branches of service. Burns was a horse enthusiast, and avid golfer and bowler in the Woodlake Bowling League. He was predeceased by his parents; his wife of 61 years, Rachel B. Robertson; brothers, Eddie, Richard and George Robertson; and sisters, Olga Craun and Betty Leetzow.

Survivors include 2 daughters, Nan Suzette Robertson of Leesburg, VA, Faith Robertson of Murrells Inlet; and 1 sister, Lillian Partlow of VA.
