C. Randall Ferguson CONWAY | C. Randall "Randy" Ferguson, 73, has gone to rest in the arms of our Heavenly Father. Mr. Ferguson was born May 20, 1934 in Charleston, West Virginia, the son of Clyde E. Ferguson and Eula Goff Evans. He was preceded in death by his parents and one grandson, Roger Worch. He graduated from Charleston High School in 1952 and Morris Harvey College in 1962. Mr. Ferguson served in the U.S. Army and worked for Kroger Co. for over 20 years. Upon leaving Kroger, he acquired several Foodland grocery stores in Parkersburg, W.Va. In 1994, the stores were sold and he went to work with New England Life Insurance until he retired in 2000. Randy was an active member of Belin United Methodist Church in Murrells Inlet. He was also active in his community, serving on the Homeowners' Association Board of Directors. He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Barbara Lipford Ferguson, of Conway, S.C.; two sons, Randall Lee Ferguson of Conway, S.C. and Kendell Layne Ferguson and his wife, Jennifer, of Murrells Inlet, S.C.; one granddaughter and two great-granddaughters of Parkersburg, W.Va.; three step grandchildren and six step great-grandchildren of Murrells Inlet, S.C. Memorial services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday, August 16, 2007, at Belin United Methodist Church. The Rev. Dr. B. Mike Alexander Jr. will officiate. 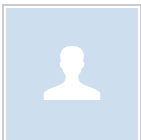
