March 24, 1936 - September 8, 2015

Mr. Carl Brown, 79, husband of Jeanette Lyerly Brown, passed away Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at MUSC in Charleston following a brief illness.

Born March 24, 1936 in Grain Valley, MO, Carl was the son of the late Carl Joyce Brown and the late Laverne Morrison. Carl was an accomplished drummer and was a band director in public schools for many years, having won three state marching band competitions. He also played in several community musical groups. Carl was a member of First Baptist Church Conway and the chancel choir. He also was a member of the Conway Kiwanis Club and the Coast Guard Auxiliary. Carl and Jeanette were involved with ??? Youth For Understanding???, hosting more than 20 exchange students over the years.

Survivors include his wife of 55 years, Jeanette Lyerly Brown; his brother, David L. Brown and wife Marilyn; his sister-in-law, Alma Lyerly; and many cherished nieces and nephews and other extended family members.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00AM Monday, September 14, 2015 at First Baptist Church Conway, officiated by Dr. Robert Guffey. 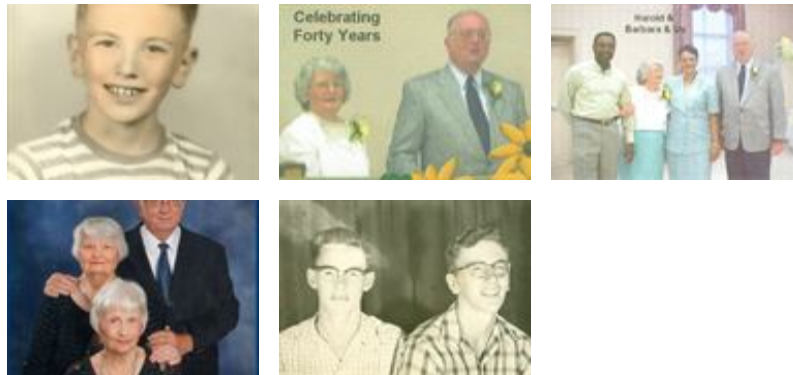
