Services will be private.

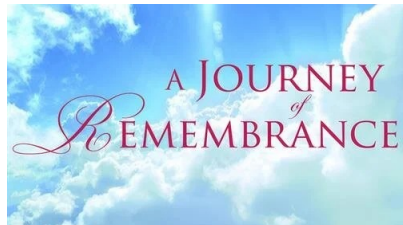
