Rev. Carl A. Grossman age 77 of Island Green, died Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at his residence.

Rev. Grossman was born on Sept. 5, 1935 in Wellsville, NY, the son of the late Clarence and Dorothy Harms Grossman.

Rev. Grossman graduated from Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, MO in 1960 and was ordained the same year into the Ministry of the Lutheran Church. He served churches as Pastor in Nebraska, the Bronx, NY, and Cornwall, CT.

After moving to Myrtle Beach with his wife to the Island Green Community in 1989, he served as the Interim Pastor and then as Assistant Pastor at Shepherd of the Sea Lutheran Church in Garden City. Pastor Grossman and his wife Shirley enjoyed many years playing golf and enjoyed sociability with many of the residents of the Island Green Golf Course. He is preceded in death by his wife, Shirley and a brother, Robert Grossman.

Rev. Grossman is survived by his son, Thomas of Ashley Falls, MA; three daughters, Lori Belter and her husband Stephen of Lakeville, CT, Beth Piantek and her husband Thomas of South Windsor, CT, Krista Haley and her husband Justin of Pasadena, CA; two step-sons, Robert Washburn of Careyville, NY; and Ronald Washburn of Torrington, CT, seven grandchildren and two sisters, Sandra Wright and Betty Wood both of Wellsville, NY.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM Monday, April 29, 2013 at Shepherd of the Sea Lutheran Church.
