Carol A. Parks, age 53 of Prestwick entered her eternal rest on Wednesday, March 23, 2005. Born March 26, 1951 in Viroqua, WI, she was the daughter of Ethel Aspenson and the late Carl Aspenson. For the past 23 years, Carol was a discussion leader for Bible Study Fellowship, International, and led numerous other Bible studies and was involved in happy fellowship at Myrtle Beach Bible Chapel. She was a devoted wife and mother, tending to her children and home while her husband was traveling in an itinerant Evangelistic Bible teaching and singing ministry. Her home was always open for friends as well as new friends. Through their married life, the people they entertained in their home filled several Guest Books with heartfelt remarks of her loving care, sweet smile and Christ-like disposition.
