December 6, 1946 - December 3, 2022

Mrs. Carol Diane Anderson, 75, widow of the late Richard B. Anderson, passed away Saturday, December 3, 2022 at her home.

Born December 6, 1946 in Conway, she was the daughter of the late James Herbert Watts and the late Jean Rosemary Roberson Watts. Carol was a graduate of Conway High School Class of 1965 and received her nursing degree from the University of South Carolina/Francis Marion College in 1971. Her nursing career spanned 35 years at Florence General Hospital and Bruce Hospital, which later became Carolinas Hospital System. She was a member of Little River United Methodist Church and also attended Trinity United Methodist Church in North Myrtle Beach.

Mrs. Anderson was predeceased by her husband and parents; her step-brother, Donald Waddington; and her brother-in-law, Randolph Lewis.
