Carol Ann Loskill, 68, entered into eternal rest on Monday, November 25, 2013. She was born in Philadelphia, PA, to the late Florence (Schell) and Wayne Huggins, Sr., and raised in Levittown, PA. After graduating from Woodrow Wilson High School in 1963, she trained at the Northeastern Hospital School of Nursing in Philadelphia, PA, and completed her Registered Nurse degree in 1966. She made her career as a Registered Nurse for over forty years, culminating as a compliance auditor for the Georgetown Hospital Systems, with whom she spent over twenty-two years. A woman of faith, she led an active church life, beginning with the Queen's Aides at the Immaculate Conception Church in Levittown, PA. In South Carolina, she belonged to the Catholic Daughters of America and the St. Michael Women's Guild. She was elected Regent of the Catholic Daughters- Court St. Michael, President of the Women's Guild, and Vice-President of the Pee Dee Deanery of the South Carolina Council of Catholic Women. She also sat on the St. Michael Parish Council and taught Sunday School.

She touched the hearts of many with her humor and her friendship.

She is survived by her loving and dedicated husband of 43 years, Richard J. Loskill, Sr., and their devoted children Richard (Sharon) Loskill, Jr., Brian (Chontel) Loskill, and Meghan (Robert) Kraus, all of Myrtle Beach. She leaves behind her sister Janice (Victor) Bandish of Morrisville, PA, and her brother

Wayne (Irene) Huggins, Jr., of Myrtle Beach. She is also survived by her loving grandchildren Shelley, Jacob, Ava, and Patrick Loskill, all of Myrtle Beach, her niece Jodie, her nephews Wayne, Daniel, Michael and James, many cousins, and countless friends.
