Carolyn M. "Lyn" Peterson, age 70 of Pawleys Island died Monday, February 25, 2013 at Georgetown Memorial Hospital.

Born on June 6, 1942 in Boston, MA, she was the daughter of the late Raymond E. Miskelly and Jessie E. Bain Miskelly. Mrs. Peterson graduated from Cape Cod Community College and attended the University of New Hampshire. She was inducted into the Plymouth High School Athletic Hall of Fame in Plymouth, MA in 1997. She retired from Bell Atlantic as a Staff Supervisor of Finance after 30 years. Mrs. Peterson was an active member of St. Paul's Waccamaw United Methodist Church where she served 2 appointments as Financial Secretary. She was active in tennis leagues prior to her illness.
