



## Cecil Dix

September 12, 1926 - February 4, 2012

Aynor... Cecil G. Dix, age 85, of Hwy. 319, passed away on Saturday, February 4, 2012 at Agape Rehabilitation of Conway.

Mr. Dix was born on September 12, 1926 in Conway, a son of the late William and Myrtle Moore Dix. He was a beloved member of Salem Baptist Church which he had been a member of since 1956. He served as Sunday School teacher, deacon and church treasurer for many decades. He was a member of the Fellowship Sunday School class, and was also a church greeter. He was a World War II Army Veteran where he served in Japan. Mr. Dix was a retired mail carrier and took time to know all the people who were on his mail route. He was past President and Vice President of the Executive Committee of the Mail Carriers Association. He was a member of the Aynor Lions Club where he was past President and Lion of the Year. Mr. Dix was President of the Aynor High School Board of Trustees and Aynor/Conway Career Center. He served as Past Commander of the American Legion, Chaplain of 40 & 8, Past Master of the Aynor Masonic Lodge, Past Patron of OES and Grand Chaplain of the SC OES. He was also a board member of the Horry County Farm Bureau. Mr. Dix was a Blue Ribbon panel representative of Horry County School District and a member of the Million Mile Club with the US Postal Service having driven one million miles without an accident. He was best known for being a loving husband, father and grandfather to his family and a pillar of the community. Mr. Dix was a blessing to everyone he met. He exemplified what a good citizen and follower of Christ should be. Mr. Dix was

predeceased by a sister, Sylvia Shelley of Sumter. Heaven has now received another saint and the angels are all rejoicing.

Surviving are the love of his life, his wife of 58 years, Elise Rabon Dix, two daughters, Cherri Dix of Myrtle Beach and Tanya Dix Merritt (Wade) of Conway, one son, Terry Dix of Charlotte, NC, two grandsons, Brandon Anderson (Davita) and Matthew Anderson (Kelli) all of Conway, four sisters, LaFrance Brown of Conway, Oneita Smith (Frank) and Laurice Owens all of Myrtle Beach, and Miriam Cook (Charles) of Sumter, four brothers, Enoch Dix (Kathleen), William Dix, Jr. (Jennifer), Weston Dix (Gloria) and Larry Gene Dix (Marie) all of Myrtle Beach, and many nieces and nephews.
