Conway...Charles Richard Eschtruth, 82, of Antioch Road, died Wednesday, June 26, 2013 at Agape Rehabilitation of Conway.

Mr. Eschtruth was born in Lorain, OH, a son of the late Donald F. and Lois Margarett Weichel Eschtruth. He was formerly of Dalton, NY, where he was a volunteer Fireman. Mr. Eschtruth was a graduate of Houghton College in 1960. He was a member of Langston Baptist Church and a member of Long Bay Symphony / Long Bay Woodwind Quartet. Mr. Eschtruth was a US Navy Veteran of the Korean Conflict. He was owner and operator of Eschtruth & Son piano tuning for 56 years, and the first resident Piano Tuner in Horry County/Grand Strand area.
