



## Charles Theodore Fuller Jr.

Charles Theodore Fuller Jr., age 80, of Myrtle Beach, SC, passed away peacefully on September 15, 2025, at the Lakes of Litchfield.

Born on November 15, 1944, in Ashland, Kentucky, he was the son of the late Charles and Hazel Waddell Fuller. Charles was raised in Ravenswood, West Virginia, and graduated from Ravenswood High School before earning his bachelor's degree from the West Virginia Institute of Technology.

It was during his college years that he met the love of his life, Helen Christian. They were married on August 1, 1968. The couple made their first home in Dunbar, West Virginia before relocating to Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. They retired to Myrtle Beach in 2004 and enjoyed a quieter life near the coast.

Charles also had a soft spot for animals and shared his life with many cherished cats over the years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 54 years, Helen Christian Fuller.

He is survived by two sons, Phillip Fuller and his wife Jennifer, and their children Cadence and Tyler; Kirk Fuller and his wife Beth, and their children Brianna and Chloe; one daughter, Christal Fuller; one sister, Brenda Plunkett; sister-in-law, Susie Bartlett and her husband Nelson and their son Jacob. He is also survived by his lifelong friend, Larry Queen.
