Charles Othel Glover (Retired CMSgt U.S. Air Force), 91, passed away on Thursday, December 2, 2021 in Conway Medical Center after a brief illness. He was born in Denton, NC, a son of the late Ralston and Nellie Gallimore Glover. He honorably served his country for 28 years in the U.S. Air Force serving during the Korean and Vietnam Wars, retiring as CMSgt.
