Charles Holcomb age 76, died Monday, December 1, 2014 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Born in Memphis, TN, he was a son of the late Ira Edward and Leona Elizabeth Holcomb. Mr. Holcomb retired as store manager of Sears after 30 years of service. After he retired, he sold one million dollars in his first year of real estate business in Mississippi. Upon moving to South Carolina, he worked for both Apache and Pirateland Campgrounds for over 15 years. He was a member of The Well by the Sea and served on vestry at Church of the Resurrection. Mr. Holcomb enjoyed playing golf, hiking, Tennessee, Ole Miss and South Carolina football.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Debbie Kirby.
