Mr. Charles E. Hunt, age 80, passed away on Tuesday, September 3, 2024, at his home.

Born May 15, 1944, in Lumberton, NC, he was the son of the late Hector and Mary Gladys Maynor Hunt. Mr. Hunt was a member of Jamestown Baptist Church. He served in the US Army during the Vietnam War.

Hunt; a son, Tracy Hunt (Hillary) of Fruita, CO; a daughter, Amy Floyd (Terry) of Dallas, GA; five grandchildren, Madelyn Hunt, Jayden Hunt, Marissa Hunt, Hannah Ferrell, and Gavriella Mamane; a brother, Victor "Gary" Hunt (Barbara) of Fayetteville, NC; a sister, Cindy Hunt of Manassas, VA; and a brother-in-law, Charles Cooper of Fayetteville, NC.
