Charles Frederick Kaufmann age 87, died Tuesday, April 5, 2011 at The Lakes at Litchfield.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was a son of the late Charles and E. Lenore Kaufmann. Charles was in the U.S. Navy Reserve. During WWII he served in the 79th Construction Battalion in the Aleutians. After 30 years in Public School Education, he retired as School Principal in 1980. He then owned and operated an Antique Shop in Carversville, PA.
