Charles E. Kramer, 93, of Murrells Inlet, passed to the hands of the Lord on Wednesday, Dec 28. Mr. Kramer was born in Bangor, PA. the son of the late Russell and Mildred Kramer. He subsequently lived in the Baltimore, Md. area where he was a supervisor at the Social Security Administration until his retirement. He then lived on the west coast of Florida for over 30 years before he moved to Murrells Inlet in 2005. Mr. Kramer served in the US Army Air Corps during the Second World War, spending a portion of his tour of duty in England. He had many interests: first and foremost, the love of his life, Ann, his wife of 63 years, and also woodcarving, dancing , and traveling. He and Ann traveled for many years to European and Scandinavian countries and Australia and New Zealand as well as within the US and Canada.

Mr. Kramer was preceded in death by his only sibling, a sister, Ethel Buzzard and her husband Stewart.

In addition to his wife, other survivors include his nephew Wayne Buzzard and wife Mary of Florida; nephew David Buzzard and wife Jan of Pennsylvania and a niece Kathy Fiorot and husband John of Pennsylvania. Also surviving is his niece through marriage, Dee Horton and her husband, Lee, of Murrells Inlet.
