MSgt. Charles "Charlie" Pryor, USAF (Ret.), 81, passed away at home on July 10, 2019 after an extended illness.

Charlie was born October 27, 1937 in Miami, FL. He was the son of the late Homer C. and Reba Russell Pryor. Charlie was a Vietnam Veteran who proudly served his country in the United States Air Force, retiring after 21 years of service. Following his time in the Military, Charlie was a Firefighter in North Myrtle Beach and a volunteer Firefighter for Horry County. He was awarded the Volunteer Firefighter of the year in 2003, when he was 65. He also volunteered with the VA, driving veterans to Charleston for appointments, and with AARP teaching people how to drive up to his injury in 2018.

In his spare time, you could find Charlie outside, where he loved to tinker with anything that needed fixing. Charlie loved animals and living in the country. Above all, Charlie was a cherished father and devoted grandfather. He lived to serve others. Charlie was preceded in death by his wife of 40 years Sarah "Peggy" Pryor, his daughter Sheila Pryor-Derrick; and his loyal four-legged companion, Spencer.

Surviving are his daughter Deborah (Sarah-Kolster) Pryor of VA; grandchildren Trevor Derrick, Jackson Pryor-Kolster and Caroline Pryor-Kolster; several nieces and nephews; caretaker and special friend Gena Greene.
